### *Meaford Residents Urge Council to Give Citizens of Meaford a Voice in TC Energy Proposal*

On Monday, February 26 th , Meaford residents will implore Meaford Council to ensure that local citizens are given an opportunity to speak to the impacts of TC Energy's controversial \$4.5 billion pumped storage proposal.

Meaford Council had moved to set up a Community Pumped Storage Advisory Committee, but at the February 12 th meeting, after receiving a strongly-worded letter from TC Energy Project Director, John Mikkelsen, Council deferred its decision on the setting up of the committee.

Despite widespread opposition from community members, in 2023 Council provided a conditional approval to be a "Willing Host" for the project.

With opposition of the project now spreading beyond local jurisdictions, town councils from across the Georgian Bay Basin are now actively voicing concerns about the proposal.
